2 07-05-2015 This is an application seeking anticipatory bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under sections 304B of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law respectively of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted, drawing my attention to the first information report, that there is no specific allegation of demand of dowry against these petitioners prior to death of deceased though there is such allegation against the husband of deceased. He has submitted that no offence under section 304B of the IPC is made out so far the petitioners are concerned.

Be that as it may, in view of submission that there is no

allegation of demand of dowry against these petitioners prior to death of deceased, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/ surrender within a period of six weeks from today shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in connection with Murar PS case No. 17/2014, subject to condition as laid down u/s 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
