Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
341, 427, 504 and 353 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged by the informant that the informant
was making local survey of the houses, affected in flood,
then the petitioner pressurized to include his and his
family members name in the beneficiary list.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that only on suspicion the accusation has been
levelled. Statement has been made in para-3 of the
petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of allegation, let the above

named petitioner be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Biroul at Benipur, Darbhanga in connection with Biroul P.S. Case No. 297 of 2014, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Indian Penal Code.
