Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order of non-discharge dated 31.3.2009 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Buxar in G.R. No. 885 of 1997, Trial No. 795 of 2008 arising out of Buxar (T) P.S. Case No. 139 of 1997.

Having gone through the records of the case, I do not find any merit in the application, the same is dismissed.
