Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The allegation against the petitioner is of torturing the complainant for non-fulfilment of additional demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He is ready to keep the complainant as his wife with full dignity and honour. It is also submitted that the petitioner is ready to deposit an amount of Rs. 1500/- (Fifteen hundred only) per month in the court below, which may be released in favour of the complainant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to deposit an amount of Rs.1500/- (Fifteen hundred only) per month in the court below, which shall be released in favour of the complainant.

Let the above named petitioner, in the event of arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Srimati Nur Sultana, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Hajipur, vaishali in connection with Complaint Case no. C-1313/12, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
