2 27-04-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners
and the State.

The petitioner no.1 being the brother-in-law, petitioners no.2 and 3 being the Gotani(sisters-in-law) and petitioner no.4 being the nephew of the deceased are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302 and 328/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of administering the poison to the daughter of the informant.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that there is general and omnibus allegations against the petitioners and there is direct accusation against the husband of the deceased.

Considering the specific accusation against the husband of the deceased let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Manjhagarh P.S. Case No.88 of 2014 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M. Gopalganj subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
