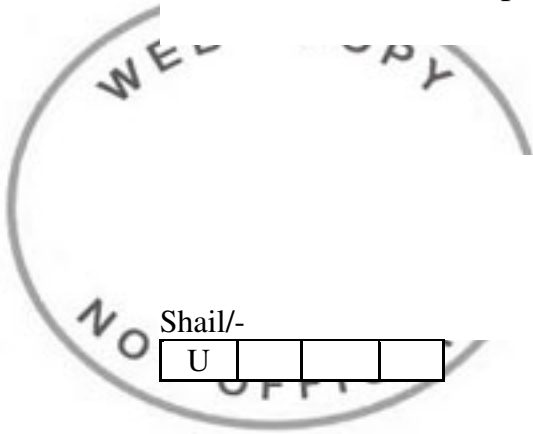

In the light of order of the High Court under contempt, the Superintendent of Police, Saran at Chapra has passed the District Order no. 215/2015 bearing Memo No. 317 dated 25.01.2015 directing payment of arrears of salary to the petitioner within one week from the date of the order.

In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner has agree to withdraw the contempt application which is disposed of granting liberty to the appellant that if the payment

is not made within the time, as indicated above, he may file a short contempt petition with liberty to mention.
