Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered under Section 498(A) and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the husband and he is ready to keep his wife. The petitioner filed a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act for restitution of conjugal rights. It is submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are false and concocted.

Considering the willingness of the petitioner to keep his wife, the above named petitioner is directed to surrender in the court below within four weeks from today and the court below shall, after issuing notice to the informant, grant provisional bail to

the petitioner on furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 228/15.

The court below shall make all efforts for reconciliation of the dispute between the husband and the wife. If the dispute is resolved amicably between the parties, the provisional bail granted to the petitioner shall be confirmed. In case the dispute is not resolved, the court below shall pass orders on the prayer for provisional bail of the petitioner on its own merit in accordance with law.
