2 12-01-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner being husband of the victim is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of assaulting the victim as a result she died.
