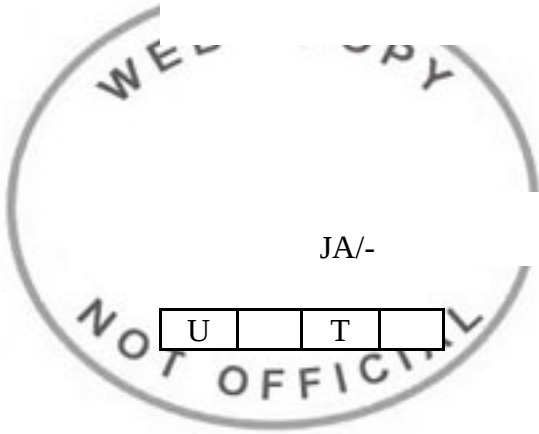
The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order of non-discharge dated 01.05.2012 passed in Sessions Trial No.282 of 2011/282-A of 2011 arising out of Amba P.S. Case No.93 of 2010 by the Additional Sessions Judge, FTC No.5, Aurangabad.

Since the Petitioner seeks quashing on disputed question of facts which cannot be gone into at this stage, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application is **dismissed**.
