Heard both sides.

The petitioner prays for extension of time of surrender.

Petitioner was granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 16.05.2014 but eh
petitioner did not surrender in the court below.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he fell ill
and therefore, he could not inform the petitioner to surrender within four
weeks from the date of receipt of the order. It is of course laches on the part
