2. 17-06-2015 Heard Sri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned counsel for
petitioners and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

Two petitioners, apprehending their arrest in
connection with Complaint Case No. 2130(C) of 2013 registered
for the offence under Sections 420, 34 of the Indian Penal Code,
have prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that
petitioners and complainant are own *gotiya* and it has been alleged
that petitioners have sold land beyond their share. He submits that
in a civil dispute, colour of criminal offence has been given.

I have perused the materials on record.

In view of the facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, namely; Dabloo Kumar @ Dabloo Sah and Lalan Sah in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of one month from today be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of **Rs. 10,000/-** (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Rameshwar Mishra, learned J.M. Ist Class, Begusarai/concerned court in connection with Complaint Case No. 2130 “C” of 2013, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
