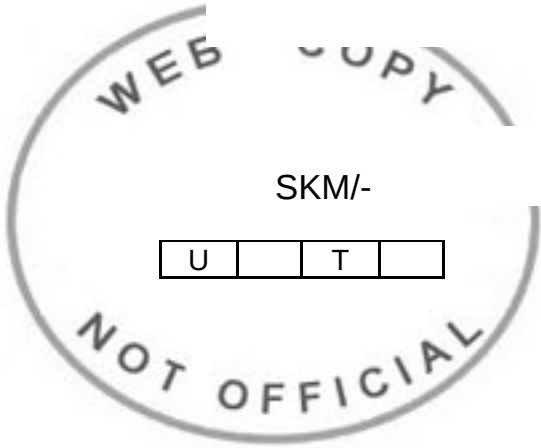

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Looking at the nature of the allegation coupled
with the assertion made in the anticipatory bail
application with regard the reason as to the dispute,
anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above-named, in the event
of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks
from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond
of Rs. 25,000/- (twenty five thousand) with two sureties
of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief
Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur, in connection with C.R.
No. 665 of 2013, which shall be abide by the terms and

conditions mentioned in sub-section (2) of section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
