ORAL ORDER

2 11-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Phulwari Sharif P.S. Case No. 591 of 2013 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 498-A /307 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
allegation of demand of dowry and torture against the petitioner.

Considering the vague nature of allegation made
against the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner is willing
to keep his wife with full dignity and honour and there shall be no

recurrence of untoward incident, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. 1st Class, Patna in connection with Phulwari Sharif P.S. Case No. 591 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
