Apprehending his arrest, the petitioner filed

A.B.P. No.968A of 2013/400 of 2014 in the court of

learned Sessions Judge, Kaimur at Bhabua. The same

was dismissed on 17.5.2014. Hence, this application for

anticipatory bail under Section-438 of Cr.P.C.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P. for the State.

Whether one goes by the nature of

allegations or the law laid down by the Supreme Court in

the recent past, the arrest of a person who figured as

accused in a case wherein offences punishable under Section-498A of I.P.C. is alleged, is not at all warranted.

Having gone into the facts and circumstances of the case, application is allowed.

In the event of arrest, let the petitioner named above be enlarged on anticipatory bail upon furnishing the bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) along with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Bhabua (Kaimur) in connection with Complaint Case No.237 of 2013/Tr. No.2984/2013, subject to the conditions laid down under Section-438(2) of Cr.P.C.
