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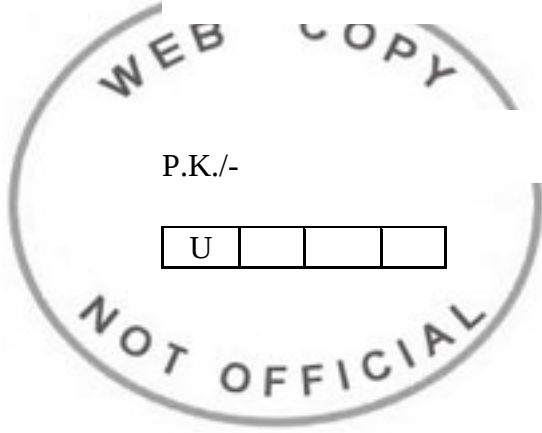

2 07-07-2015 The writ application is required to be dismissed because after perusal, it is apparent that adequate opportunity was given to the petitioner and a very detailed kind of hearing even allowed at the level of the appellate authority.

The fact reveals itself how the centre is being run. The object for which these centers have been set up is being defeated by the conduct of such Anganwari Sevikas, who are not the Government servants. C.C.A. rules are not required to be applied to them. Rules of natural justice has been complied

with and infirmity emerges from the impugned orders.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
