**Appearance :**

“That, the petitioner again reiterates at the cost of repetition that the petitioner has not solemnized any marriage with Parvati Devi which was wholly false and purposefully alleged by the complainant.”

On instructions, it is submitted that the petitioner is ready to keep the complainant as wife with full dignity and honour. Statement to the aforesaid effect has been made in paragraph no. 10 of the petition which reads as follows:

“That, the petitioner is ready to live with the complainant as a wife and husband whereas the complainant does not respect the sanctity of marriage”

Considering the present stand of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be released on provisional anticipatory bail for one year in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM Banka in connection with Complaint Case No. 239 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

complainant to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

The provisional bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by the learned court below in three eventualities – (i) if the matrimonial harmony is substantially restored or (ii) if the complainant fails to appear before the learned court below or (iii) if the complainant deliberately gets reluctant to reconcile the issue but the provisional bail will not be confirmed by the learned court below if substantial proof comes that the petitioner has performed second marriage and in that event the petitioner will surrender and pray for regular bail.
