Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner being the sister-in-law of the victim is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302 and 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the informant after ten years of the marriage.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the accusation is not specific against the petitioner whereas the son of the victim in 164 Cr. P.C. statement, has stated that the victim died due to illness in presence of informant and informant's son. The same has been brought on record as Annexure-2.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or

surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M., 1st Class, Banka in connection with Katoria (Suia) P.S. Case No. 159 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
