2 07-08-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 341,323,406 and 504 of
the Indian Penal Code and section 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Caste
and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

It is alleged that when the informant went to ask for the
due wages the petitioner and others abused by calling the caste
name.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner
that for the occurrence of 11.3.2014 the FIR was registered on
25.3.2014 and admittedly the occurrence took place at the door of
the informant hence that cannot be treated to be a place of public
view.

Considering the delayed lodging of the FIR, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Hajipur Sadar P.S. Case No.129 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
