The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order of
non-discharge dated 27.08.2014 passed by the Ad hoc
Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Darbhanga in S.Tr. No. 144
of 2013).

Considering that the Petitioner seeks quashing
on disputed questions of fact which can not be gone into
at this stage, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The Application is dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial
and conclude the same without granting unnecessary
