In view of the submissions raised in
Interlocutory Application No. 598 of 2015, let the
name of the petitioner be expunged from the array
of parties and he be substituted by his wife Smt.
Chinta Devi.

2. Interlocutory Application No. 598 of
2015 is, accordingly, disposed of.

3. Heard learned counsel for the
petitioner and the State.

4. It appears husband of the petitioner
was getting 90% pension until his death as a Cr.

Appeal filed by him is pending in the High Court. During pendency of the said Cr. Appeal substituted petitioner, in my opinion, is also entitled for payment of 90% family pension amount.

5. Let the authorities make payment of 90% family pension to the substituted petitioner with effect from the date of death of her husband i.e. 11.01.2014.

6. The writ application is, accordingly, disposed of.
