2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the

offences alleged under Sections 498A of the Indian Penal
Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the D.P.Act registered in
connection with Complaint Case No. 1910 of 2013.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been

falsely implicated as all the accusations are general and
omnibus in nature. No specific act of torture or demand of
dowry has been attributed against the petitioner.
