4 16-03-2016 Pursuant to order dated 24.02.2016 the parties are
personally present in Court today.

2. It is common ground that the parties are ready and willing
to resume their harmonious conjugal life after leaving the Court
premises together. The petitioner undertakes and reiterates his
commitment to keep his wife with due dignity and honour
henceforth.

3. Having regard to the entirety of the facts and
circumstances of the case, in the event of the petitioner's arrest or
surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of
communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten

thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Noor Sultana, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Vaishali at Hajipur, connection with C.I. Case No. 2072 of 2013, Trial No. 5684 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., with additional condition that if in future any similar complaint/FIR is filed by the OP No. 2 against the petitioner, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
