Petitioner applied for recognition for A.N.M. course before the authorities of the Bihar Health Department. By virtue of Annexure-1 dated 27.01.2012, even an inspection committee was set up which carried out the inspection and submitted a report as far back as 26.03.2012. It is the inaction on the part of the respondent authorities to take a call that has generated an unnecessary litigation.

In stead of adjourning the matter for a counter affidavit, the Court would direct the Director-in-Chief, Health Services,

Government of Bihar to decide on the question of recognition within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.

Writ application is disposed of with the above direction.
