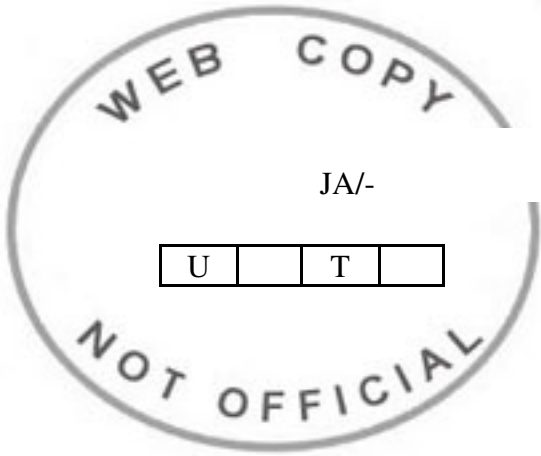
It has been submitted that the Petitioner's product was not substandard as is evident from Annexure-5 that nowhere it was claimed that it contained vitamin B2 which was found absent on analysis.

Considering that these are the matters which can be looked into only at the stage of trial, I see no reason to interfere in the matter.

The application is **dismissed**.

The Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial

expeditiously without granting unnecessary adjournment to any party.
