5 04-05-2015 Despite repeated calls, none appears on behalf of the petitioner in support of the present writ petition.

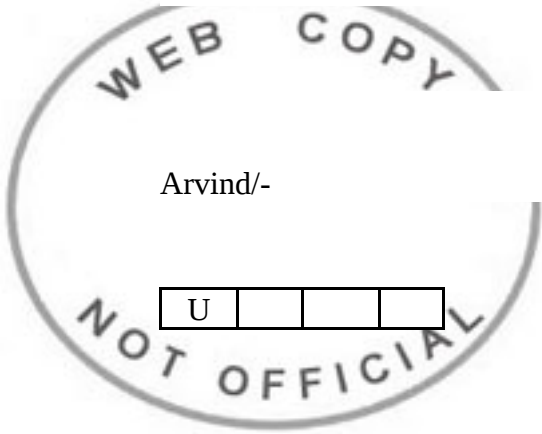
