Petitioner submits that after death of his father, who was holding D.B.B.L. gun, after granting licence by the competent authority, he had applied for licence in the year 2014. It is contended that the aforesaid D.B.B.L. gun stands deposited before the arms dealer.

In above view of the matter, this writ application is being disposed of with a direction to the respondent no. 3 to take a final decision in the matter in accordance with law within four months from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order also considering the Family Heirloom Policy, if the decision has already not been taken.
