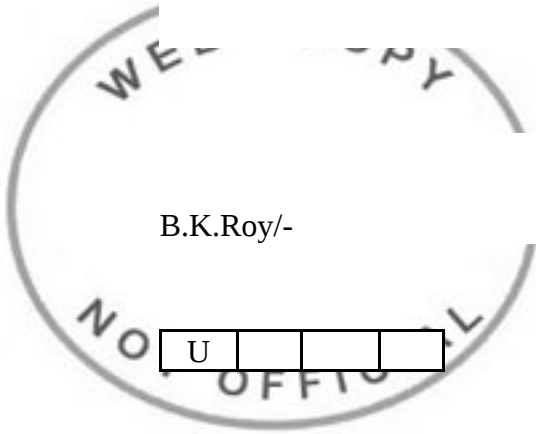
Learned counsel for the petitioners states that these
