2 14-10-2015 Heard Sri Dinesh Prasad Verma, learned counsel for
the petitioners and learned A.P.P.

Two petitioners, apprehending their arrest in connection
with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 262 of 2014 registered for the
offence punishable under Section 307 and other allied Sections of
the Indian Penal Code, have prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

It was submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners
that there was case and counter case between the parties and
petitioner no. 1 and informant of the present case are relatives.
He further submits that the informant was examined by the
doctor and injuries were found as simple in nature.

In view of the facts and circumstances, let both the

petitioners namely, Pintu Yadav and Sintu Yadav in the event of their arrest or surrender within a period of eight weeks from today be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 262 of 2014.
