The prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside the order dated 9.12.2013 of the Principal Secretary in respect of settlement of the *Baalu Ghats* of the calendar year 2014.

Although a prayer for pass over has been made by learned counsel Mr. Yogesh Kumar but Mr. Rajendra Prasad

appearing for the respondent Mining Department with reference to the impugned order present at Annexure-2 submits that the writ petition itself has been rendered infructuous by passing of the year 2014 inasmuch as the grievance was with regard to settlement of the *Baalu Ghats* for the year 2014 which stands exhausted.
