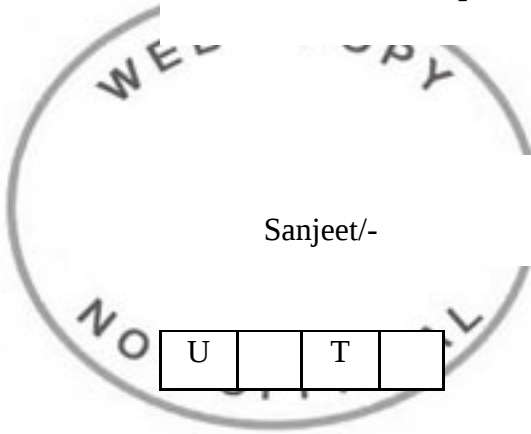
ORAL JUDGMENT
