The petitioner is a stranger to the case. He is neither informant nor accused in S.K. Puri P.S. Case No. 520 of 2013 registered under Section 302 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The petitioner has filed this application under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction from this Court to be issued to the respondents to hand over investigation
