The petitioners seek quashing of the F.I.R. bearing Sonapur P. S. Case No. 392 of 2012 arising out of Complaint Case No. 2592 of 2012 for offences punishable under sections 406, 420, 504 and 120 (B) of I.P.C.

Allegation of the informant Mukesh Kumar is that the petitioners along with others have cheated and induced him to pay Rs. 3.5 lakhs for recruitment in the service of Indian Army or any other government job. The witness, Umesh Kumar has also filed a complaint case No. 3327 of 2012, making allegations for offences,

punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 120 B and 504 of the I.P.C.

After perusing the records and after due consideration of the facts of the case, the application stands rejected. However, liberty is given to the petitioners to raise all the points raised in this application at the time of framing of charge.
