Remedy for the petitioner lies in a suit if there is change in the revenue register of Khatiyani with regard to the owner of the land purportedly donated by the father of the present petitioner for a school. It is evident from record that a suit was filed earlier but not pursued, therefore, dismissed. Let petitioner get it restored and pursue the matter.

Such dispute does not come under purview of Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Writ application is dismissed.
