3 13-01-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Angarh P.S. Case No. 8 of 2014 for the offence registered
under Section 302 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal
Code.

The father of the deceased made allegation that his
daughter was killed by her husband and other in-laws.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that police

after investigation, submitted chargesheet under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

It appears that informant made allegation that her husband strangled his wife to death.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

However, the Trial Court is hereby directed to expedite and conclude the trial within a period of nine months from the date of this order. If, the trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail firstly in the trial court.
