ORAL ORDER

2 07-12-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections
420,465,467,469,471,149 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is of lodging title suit and filing
an unregistered deed therein by forging the signature of the
informant.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner
that for the same cause of action an application was filed by the
informant before the court where title suit is pending.

Considering the fact that in pending title suit forgery
has been alleged to have been made and statement made in
paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal

antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Manjhaul, Begusarai in connection with CBR (Majhaul) P.S. Case No.178 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
