Petitioners are apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 353, 171(H), 171(F), 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is that during last assembly election the informant was deputed as Magistrate along with other police officers for the purposes of checking the vehicle for security purposes when the petitioners being bodyguards of MLC Rajan Singh and others made assault to constable Mukesh.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that injury has been found to be superficial, simple in nature and in the background of petty scuffle the accusation has been levelled.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

The aforesaid facts constitute ground for consideration of prayer for regular bail, if the petitioners surrender within a period of six weeks in connection with Deo P.S. Case No. 64 of 2015, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad.

With the observations above, the application stands disposed off.
