Advocate – 2, makes a prayer for disposal of the present writ petition so that in view of Clause 8 of the Guidelines for appointment of Anganbari Sevika, the petitioner may file an appropriate complaint before the District Magistrate supported with an affidavit.

The writ petition stands disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to file complaint alongwith affidavit before the District Magistrate. If such complaint is filed within a period of eight weeks from today, the District Magistrate, East Champaran,

Motihari is required to get the matter enquired and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, preferably; within a period of three months from the date of filing of such complaint.
