In view of the limited prayer made at the time of hearing, this writ application is being disposed of, without going into the merit of the case, with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 7 for redressal of his grievances. In case such a representation along with a copy of this order is filed by the petitioner, let the respondent no. 7 consider it and take a decision on its own merit and in accordance with law within a period of

two months from the date of its filing.

It is made clear that if it is found that the petitioner has worked and some amount is due to be paid to him, then the same be paid to him immediately. In case any adverse decision is taken against the petitioner, then such decision should be immediately communicated to him.
