3 22-07-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri Ajay Bihari Sinha, learned SC-19.

The petitioner, in present petition, has prayed for review of order dated 21.10.2013 passed in C.W.J.C. No.16146 of 2012. The order dated 21.10.2013 is quoted herein below:
