4 17-08-2015 Heard Mr. Sunil Kumar for the petitioner and Mr. Ajay Kumar Singh for the Zila Parishad.

A counter affidavit is stated to have been filed by the Zila Parishad on and around 26.11.2013. Let the office trace out the same and place the same along with the records.

The petitioner had moved this Court against enhancement of the rent of a residential hotel from Rs. 7,500/- to 15,000/-.

The matter has remained pending since 2012 and has been taken up today when Mr. Ajay Kumar Singh learned counsel for the Zila Parishad, Motihari, District- East Champaran submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and the
