State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case under
Section 341 and 354/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 (1)
(x) (xi) of the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of
Atrocities) Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there
is no allegation that the petitioners hurled any abuses against the
girl. He further submits that there is still no allegation of any
specific misbehaviour. He further submits that no case under
SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act would be made out.

In my view, if the petitioners surrender before the court below and pray for regular bail, the same would be disposed of on the same day taking into consideration the submissions noted above.

This application stands disposed.
