ORAL ORDER

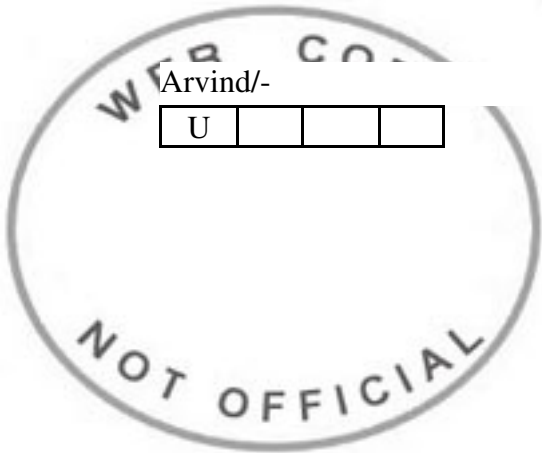

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent no.5 submits that, in fact, the present writ petition stood dismissed in the year 2012 itself on account of non-compliance of the Court's peremptory order dated 10.09.2012.
