arising out of Raxaul P.S. Case No.181 of 2013 instituted under
Section(s) 20-B, 22, 23, 24 of the NDPS Act, pending before the
6th Additional Sessions Judge, East Champaran at Motihari.

Considering the nature and amount of incriminating
