Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is languishing in jail since 19.02.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that 4-5 persons surrounded the informant and snatched Rs. 20,125/- subsequently, he reached village home then some villagers conveyed him that the petitioner Ganesh Mahato, co-accused Nagendra Singh, Mohan Singh and Bhushan Sah were the persons who kidnapped the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that merely on suspicion, the accusation has been levelled and till date petitioner has not been put on T.I. parade. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali in connection with Mahua P.S. Case No. 550 of 2010.
