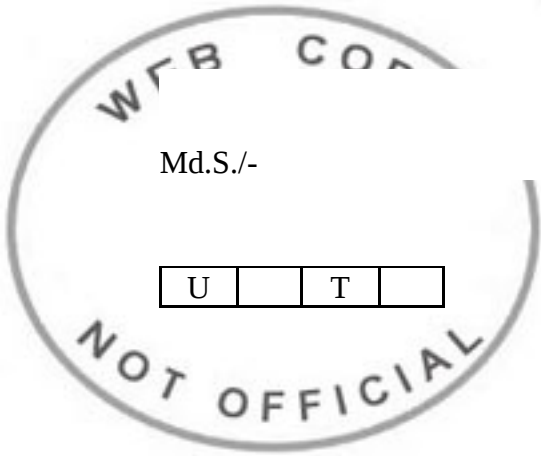
S.R.P.Bakshi seeks leave to withdraw the present writ petition in
