Respondent No 9, in the writ proceedings, is the
appellant in this intra-Court appeal assailing the judgment and
order dated 13.03.2012 of the learned Single Judge passed in
CWJC No 13640 of 2011 setting aside the order of the Teachers'
Appointment Appellate Authority, Siwan which had rejected the
writ petitioner's application on grounds of limitation. The learned

Single Judge allowed the writ petition and remanded the matter to the Authority. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the Authority has found no merit in the application of the writ petitioner and, as such, dismissed the appeal.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the appellant states that he has no cause to pursue now and the appeal be disposed of as infructuous. He, thus, seeks leave to withdraw this appeal. Leave is granted and the appeal is disposed of as infructuous.
