State.

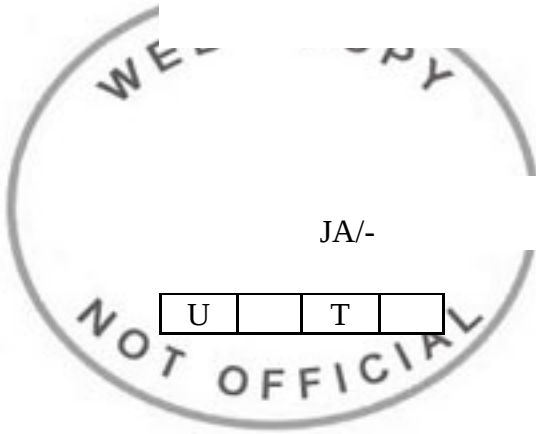
Petitioner seeks bail in Digha P.S. Case No.170 of
