Enough time has elapsed because the dispute related to formation of a Managing Committee relatable to year 2008. The time has come when a fresh decision is required to be taken afresh. If it leads to any kind of dispute it can be taken to the appropriate forum. The present dispute even other wise is required to be resolved. The decision as rendered in Annexure-7, which is under challenge, will not come in the way, since it is a nonest order, since Special Director

has no authority to hear such appeal. However, it seems, this appeal was decided on the basis of some direction, issued in CWJC No. 8027/2001, which is another matter.

Writ is disposed of with the above observation.
