been paid to him.

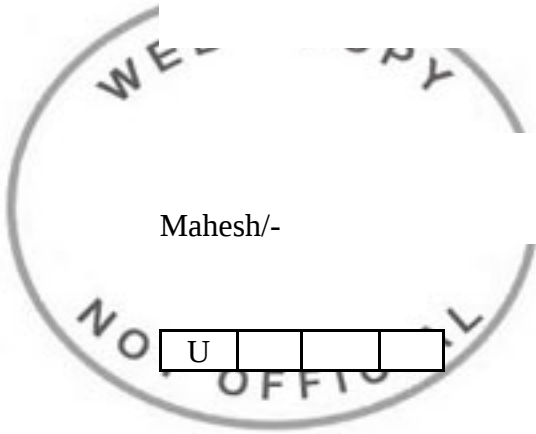
The counsel for the petitioner does not dispute, but he
