against the order dated 13.2.2012 passed by the Collector,
Muzaffarpur affirming the order dated 8.11.2010 passed by the
Sub-Divisional Officer, Muzaffarpur.

learned Commissioner would be sympathetic enough to condone
the delay as the petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this
court. It is expected that the revision application would be

filing.
